District and State Meet are options for Dolphins swimmers as well, but there are certain conditions that must be met to attend these meets. In essence, the District Meet is a qualifying opportunity for State. A swimmer who attends this meet must be willing to commit to State if he or she qualifies for the team (usually a top 3 finish at District). Or in other words, swimmers who do not plan on going to State should not register for District. The District Meet this year will be July 9th at in Gainesville; State Meet will be July 30th (for 10 & Unders) and 31st (for 11 & Ups) in Carrollton.
